**Frankenstein Fun Facts:** Frankenstein is the doctor, not the monster. The novel came from a competition between Shelley and friends to see who could write the best horror story. The book was first published in 1818 but Shelley didn't receive credit until an 1823 reprint. The plot came to Shelley in a dream. There have been 130+ film adaptations. Mary Shelley was only 18 years old when she began writing *Frankenstein*. One of the central dilemmas of the novel is the consequences / responsibility of creating new life.
