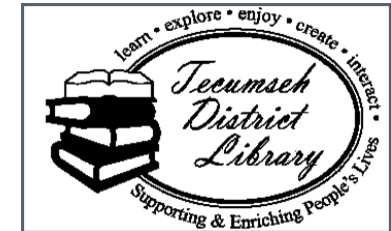
Library App

Library services and resources include public access computers, quiet study rooms, free WiFi, meeting rooms, interlibrary loan materials and quality programs for all ages.

Tecumseh District Library Loan Periods

TDL and its staff kindly request that patrons keep their library cards free of debt and obligation. Failure to do so will result in the suspension of borrowing privileges.

All lending materials may be checked out for 21 days.

Library Cards

TDL issues Resident and Non-Resident library cards to all patrons depending on the following criteria:

Resident Card: TDL is pleased to serve residents within the Tecumseh Public School District boundaries, specifically the City of Tecumseh and portions of Adrian, Franklin, Macon, Raisin, Ridgeway and Tecumseh Townships. Residents in these communities must complete a registration form and present proof of residency to receive a TDL card. A Resident Card is valid for two years.

Non-Resident Card: Patrons residing outside the TDL service area may obtain a Non-Resident Card at a rate determined by the TDL Board of Trustees. The current price of a Non-Resident Card valid for one year is \$50. A Non-Resident Card valid for 6 months is \$25.

Business Card: Patrons who own a business or work for a business within the service area may obtain a Business Card free of charge. A Business Card is valid for one year.

Teen Cards: Teens ages 16-17 years old may obtain a Teen Library Card. Teens must show a driver's license, State ID or proof of residency. This card can be converted to a regular card with a parent's signature and proof of residency. This will be a limited card with a maximum check-out of two items.

Cards for Minors: Youth under the age of 18 years will be issued their own Resident or Non-Resident Library Card when the parent or guardian signs a registration form and assumes all financial obligations. Access to the youth's borrowing record will be provided only if a release form is signed by the parent or the guardian.
