




Peer Listeners are also involved in other programs that require good listening skills like "Say No," Four County Peer Day, and Advisory board meetings in Jackson.






Straight To The Top





Along with beating class A


schools and winning the 1st tournament game in 5 years, the team also scored 77 points in their last game on parents night!



The Tecumseh Varsity Volleyball Team finished their season second in the league with a record of 9-3.


The team's captain, and most valuable player, Kelly Hartley led them in winning the County Tournament. The team came out with an overall score of 24-4, tie-



Although competition was good the coaches said it could have been tougher. All the girls on the team went to each meet determined to do the best they could and it shows through the 9-12 record.











An Improved Season




