Girls Who Code: We have started a "Girls Who Code" club at the Tecumseh District Library. Girls are able to engage in fun and simple online coding tutorials, build community through interactive activities, and learn about inspiring role models.









D&D Club and D&D Young Adventurers

Club: Come join the campaign every 2nd and 3rd Thursday of the month when we play Dungeons and Dragons. No prior knowledge of D&D or role playing games is expected and all are welcome. Our Program Supervisor, Brock Miller will take on the role of guiding newer players in many exciting adventures. **D&D Club** is for ages 16 and up - D&D Young Adventurers is for ages 10-15years.

Game Club: We meet every Wednesday from 3pm to 5pm after school. All teens in 7th to 12th grade are welcome. We play video games on Nintendo Switch such as Mario Kart 8 and Super Smash Bros among others and board games such as Settlers of Catan, Mysterium, Chess, and cards. Some Switch controllers are provided, but bringing your own is encouraged.

Teen Book Club: is a wonderful opportunity for people who are in 7th through 12th grade to read young adult fiction and non-fiction books. The teen librarian will select titles from our collection that are high interest and as current as possible. Participants will be invited to a Discord online discussion board to discuss the selections, and we will also meet monthly in person to share our thoughts.
