Summertime brings the Summer Reading Program for children, tweens, teens and adults. This year the Summer Reading Program runs from June 7-July 31. Children, tweens and teens can pick up tracking forms beginning June 7. Children (infants through 4th grade) are challenged to read 10 or 20 books (or have them read by their adult) so they can pick up their prizes. Tweens need to read 8 books to receive their gift card assortment. Teens get a chance to win some exciting prizes for reading 8 books. Adults just need to fill out a paper slip and drop it into the glass jar each time they read a book, magazine, or audio book. A drawing is held each week and the winners get a pie!

TDL Board of Trustees



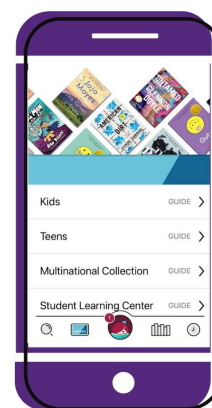

Children

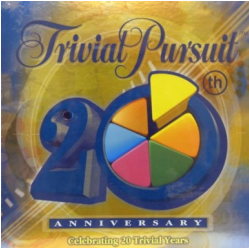
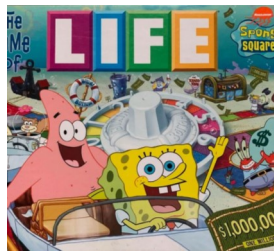
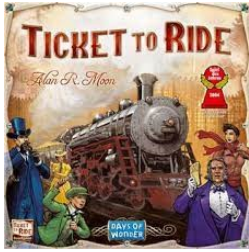
